

OSRBA YOUTH EDUCATIONAL CONTEST

- Entries will be accepted on Friday evening of OSRBA weekend from 6 pm - 7 pm in the designated youth competition area
- Entries will remain on display throughout the entirety of the show weekend
- Entries will be released on Sunday morning of the show weekend at 11 am

RULES

- Contest is open to any youth ARBA member that has a permanent resident within the state of Ohio
- Contestants must be a member of the ARBA no later than April 1st preceding the competition
- One entry form must be completed with each entry
- Attendance at OSRBA show weekend is not required
- Contestants may enter as many classes as they choose, but only one entry can be submitted per class
- Each entry must include a rabbit or cavy as part of the design and be informational or promotional of either rabbits or cavies
- Each entry must be the work of the contestant and must have been completed within the 12 months prior to OSRBA show weekend
- Contestant's name, address, age and class entered must be clearly indicated on the back/bottom/inside of each entry.
- Each contestant is responsible for the transportation of their entry to and from the show weekend.
- Age for OSRBA contest is determined by age of contestant on last day of OSRBA convention weekend (Sunday)

AGE DIVISIONS

Junior: Ages 5-11

Intermediate: Ages 12-14

Senior: Ages 15-18

Special Instructions/Directions within Classes

POSTER

☐ Class 1

- Overall size to be 22x28" and HORIZONTAL (landscape) orientation. Can be foam board or single sheet with stiff backing. Any other size or orientation WILL receive a point penalty.

DISPLAY

☐ Class 2

- Must be mounted on tri-fold board or self supporting display board with items arranged for viewing in front. The display board should provide information regarding the item(s) on display. (ie: medicine kits display with information on board)

GAME

☐ Class 3

- MUST include play instructions

CRAFTS

- Displays to best suit and protect the item(s)
- Item must be clearly and easily visible
- Display boxes are allowed. We recommend plastic or plexiglass and are not responsible for broken glass

☐ Class 4: Ceramics & Pottery

☐ Class 5: Clothing (made by exhibitor) or Wearable Art

☐ Class 6: Handmade Jewelry

☐ Class 7: Any other craft

PHOTOGRAPHY

- Photos are to be no smaller than 4x6 and no larger than 11x14
- Photos may be vertical or horizontal and must be mounted for display
- Please avoid using glass framing - we are not responsible for broken glass
- Easel may be used to display photographs
- Photo series is to consist of 3 to 6 photos mounted together to tell a story or convey an idea

CREATIVE WRITING

- Exhibit in a protective report cover or clear sleeve

- 3D Printed items must include a collage with captions or project booklet showing the processing steps of your work in progress. This can either be written, screenshot, or pictures.
- Information should include but not limited to:
 - Modeling: Your design or computer design program/software used.
 - Statement of Process: Printer make & model, slicer software used, type of material (type of filament/resin used) type of supports used.
 - Post Processing: Finishing required for your project ie: support removal, sanding/smoothing, painting etc.

ART

- Must be mounted on stiff backing or framed and ready for display
- Use of wire hangers, sawtooth, or easel for display is optional
- Glass is discouraged - we are not responsible for broken glass
